Guidelines For Writing Short Paper

The works that will be submitted must not have been previously published or currently undergoing publication in any other conference or publication platform. If there are co-authors, their approval for the submission should be obtained. The submitted work should not be a direct copy or contain plagiarized content from other sources, and it should reflect the original contributions of the authors. Whenever using the work or words of others, proper citation or quotation should be employed.

The following guidelines should be followed for preparing the short paper:

1. A self-explaining title of the short paper.
2. Name of all the authors.
3. Current affiliation of all the authors.
4. Abstract: A short abstract of 200-250 words.
5. At least 5 meaningful keywords (maximum 7).
6. Introduction: It should contain the problem statement, research gap, objective (s) of the work, and contribution of the work.
7. Study area: This section may include a map showing the study area.
8. Methodology: It should contain the data and their sources; method(s) that are used for solving the problem.
9. Results: This section may contain necessary sub-sections. Results showing by figures and tables along with texts are preferable.
10. Discussion: Discussion to justify the results using references wherever needed.
11. Conclusion: Apart from the findings of the work, this section should include the limitation of the work as well as future research direction.
12. Acknowledgment: Acknowledge the respective authority, and people if you would get any assistance from them.

13. References: A list of references containing all the used citations in the paper. Follow the APA reference style
14. **Page number of the manuscript: 2-4 pages in total, excluding the reference list.**
15. All figures should be original and 300 dpi or more.
16. Follow the APA table format.
17. The manuscript should have less than 20% plagiarism (We will use a plagiarism checker for this).
18. Use font type “Times New Roman” throughout the manuscript.
