How to reach to Castellón?

- From <u>Barajas Airport</u> you can take the metro/underground to <u>Atocha Renfe</u> (the main railway station in Madrid).
- The journey by taxi from the airport to the station normally costs around 30 Euros, however heavy traffic at certain times of the day can cause this price to increase dramatically.
- From the Atocha there are direct trains Madrid-Castellón or Madrid-Valencia (and then take a 55-minute train to Castellón). You can consult Renfe (the train agency): and better to buy your ticket online in advance.
- If you come in Madrid-Valencia train, from Valencia's main train station, <u>Estación del Norte</u>, you can catch a train to Castellón. The train journey takes around 1 hour and 15 minutes. Check the train schedules and purchase tickets at the station or through the official website of Renfe.
- Once you arrive in Castellón, you can use public bus system that can take you
 to the hotel. You can check the local bus routes and find out if any buses pass
 close to your hotel from the train station. Bus stops are usually located near
 the train station, and you can purchase tickets on board or at designated
 ticket both.

How to reach to Castellón?

- It is possible to take a commuter train (departures every 30 minutes) from the El Prat Airport to the "Barcelona Sants" railway station or to take a taxi.
- From El Prat airport, take the free shuttle bus or walk to Terminal 2 (T2). From the T2, The commuter train will start and you can go the Barcelona Sants.
- If you arrived at Terminal 1 (T1). The terminals are connected, and the shuttle journey takes about 10 minutes.
- If you reach Terminal 2, head to the train station located in the basement of the building. Follow the signs for "Rodalies de Catalunya" (Catalan commuter trains).
- At Barcelona Sants, take a train to Castellón, (the minimum ticket costs aprox. 17 Euros). You can consult <u>Renfe</u> (the train agency) and better to buy your ticket online in advance. Be aware that the last train to Castellón is at 20:30 (most days).
- Board the train and enjoy the approximately 2-hour journey to Castellón. Trains usually run frequently throughout the day, but it's recommended to check the timetable in advance.
- Once you arrive in Castellón, you can use public bus system that can take you
 to the hotel. You can check the local bus routes and find out if any buses pass
 close to your hotel from the train station. Bus stops are usually located near
 the train station, and you can purchase tickets on board or at designated
 ticket both.

How to reach to Castellón?

- The best way to get to the València Nord railway station ("Estación del Norte") from the airport is by metro line directly to the train station (metro stop "Xàtiva") with lines 3 or 5.
- The trip is roughly 20 minutes. From Xàtiva, take escalators/stairs up to street level and cross the street to València Nord.
- If you are using bus service to reach Valencia train station, upon arrival at Valencia Airport, exit the terminal and look for the shuttle bus that will take you to the Valencia city center. The bus stop is located just outside the terminal building, and the journey to Estación del Norte takes around 20-30 minutes.
- You could also take the taxi or from Valencia Nord or you can take the local train to reach Castellón.
- If you using train, you can take C-6 train to reach Castelló de la Plana.
- Once you arrive in Castellón, you can use public bus system that can take you
 to the hotel. You can check the local bus routes and find out if any buses pass
 close to your hotel from the train station. Bus stops are usually located near
 the train station, and you can purchase tickets on board or at designated
 ticket both.
