

Guidelines For Poster

The works that will be submitted must not have been previously published or currently undergoing publication in any other conference or publication platform. If there are co-authors, their approval for the submission should be obtained. The submitted work should not be a direct copy or contain plagiarized content from other sources, and it should reflect the original contributions of the authors. Whenever using the work or words of others, proper citation or quotation should be employed.

The following guidelines should be followed for preparing the poster:

- 1. The poster should have a self-explaining title.
- 2. It should include the name of the author(s).
- 3. It should include the affiliation of the presenter.
- 4. Motivation: Motivation behind doing this work with 100-150 words.
- 5. Study area: This section will have only a map or a very short description of the study area.
- 6. Methods: This section will show the specific methods used in the work.
- 7. Results: Figures and tables can be used for showing results instead of only text. All figures should have a high resolution (at least 300 dpi).
- 8. Contribution of the work: A brief contribution of the work.
- 9. References: If the citation is used in the method sections, references should be mentioned here. In this regard, the API reference style should be followed.
- 10. Contact information: Email address of the presenter or the corresponding author for further communication, if anyone is interested to communicate later with you.









Design

- Dimensions: A0 size (approx. 1.20m x 0.90m or 4' x 3')
- The background of the poster should be white and the color of the text is black
- Arrangement: Clear, simple, and uncluttered
- Lettering: Title 8cm in height
- Authors' names and affiliations are somewhat smaller
- Everything should be readable from a distance of 1.5m 2m(5' 7')
- Use simple and clear font type. When using colors, make sure to have high contrast

The presented posters will be hosted online in a "Poster gallery section" of the GeoMundus website.

Note: The presenter will pay the cost of printing the poster.

Option 1: The presenter can bring the poster himself/herself.

Option 2: The presenter can send the poster's soft copy (both PDF and . PPT files) to the program team (program@geomundus.org) for printing and will have to pay the printing cost. The cost of printing the poster as well as the way of paying the cost will be available on the conference website soon or/and the program team will send this information to the presenter while sending the abstract acceptance notification.
